Roosevelt Warm Springs Institute for Rehabilitation Internship Program for Catastrophic Rehabilitation Supplier Applicants

In partnership with the Georgia State Board of Workers' Compensation, the Roosevelt Warm Springs Institute for Rehabilitation (<u>www.rooseveltrehab.org</u>) has developed an internship program for registered rehabilitation suppliers who wish to become catastrophic rehabilitation suppliers. The goal of this program is to provide high quality clinical learning experiences for rehabilitation suppliers registered with the Georgia State Board of Workers' Compensation. The program is offered on the campus of the Institute and provides individuals an opportunity to gain up to 40 hours of Board approved credit toward the 40 hours of training required (in addition to 150 hours of observation/experience) for catastrophic rehabilitation supplier registration. As of July 1, 2001, this program is the only training for catastrophic registration applicants which is pre-approved by the Board.

A certified case manager provides the clinical supervision. This intensive program enables participants to receive quality training at a premier facility and provides an invaluable learning experience through observation of the delivery of comprehensive care for catastrophic injuries in one setting.

The experiences will include education in the following clinical areas and services:

Other experiences include attending a clinical conference, visiting patients, and participating in an optional patient recreation experience.

The program offers continuing education units (CRC, CCM, CDMS) for participants. The costs of the program are:

- If the applicant is a Board-registered rehabilitation supplier who is working toward his or her catastrophic registration, the charge is \$200.00. Room and board is included in the price of the program.
- If the applicant is already a Georgia Board-registered catastrophic rehabilitation supplier, the charge is \$400.00. Room and board is included in the price of the program.

The program is offered the first full week (excluding weeks with holidays) of each month.
